Softball and Teeball will be played at Webbs Avenue each week. Cricket will be playing at Princes Park 5/11/10.



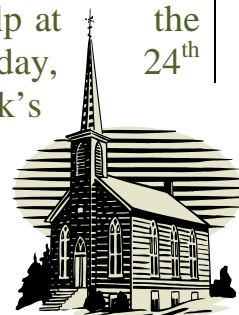
