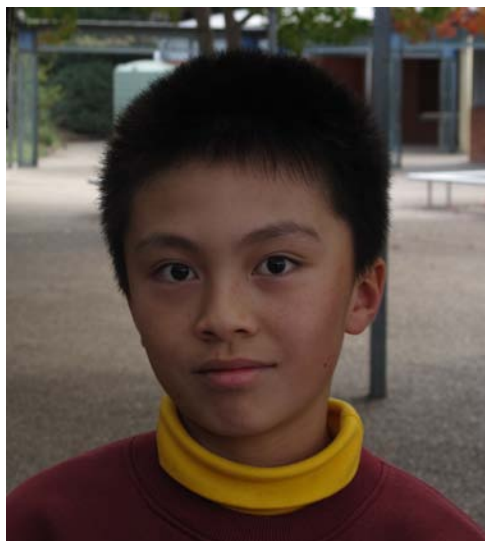


PUBLIC EDUCATION AMBASSADOR
